RE: Courtesy Notification Regarding Proposed Street Name Changes along the Greens Prairie Road West and Greens Prairie Trail Corridors

Dear Property Owner or HOA Representative:

In an effort to maximize efficiency for emergency response for fire, police, and medical services, the City of College Station strives to maintain street names and addressing that are consistent and clearly distinguishable. The Greens Prairie Road West and Greens Prairie Trail corridors have caused confusion among the traveling public as currently named and configured. In coordination with Brazos County and the Brazos County Emergency Communications District (Brazos County 9-1-1), the following street name changes are proposed to clarify these corridors (see attached exhibit):

- Area 1: rename Greens Prairie Road West between Wellborn Road (FM 2154) and Victoria Avenue as Victoria Avenue (street numbers will also need to change);
- Area 2: rename Greens Prairie Road West between Victoria Avenue and Woodlake Drive as Woodlake Drive (no addresses affected);
- Area 3: Greens Prairie Trail between I&GN Road and Woodlake Drive as Greens Prairie Road (street numbers will remain the same); and
- Area 4: rename Greens Prairie Road West between Woodlake Drive and State Highway 6 as Greens Prairie Road (street numbers will remain the same).

This letter has been provided as a courtesy since you own property or represent a Home Owners Association near the Greens Prairie Road West or Greens Prairie Trail corridors. The proposed street name changes are scheduled for consideration by the College Station City Council during their meeting on July 25, 2019 at 6:00 pm at City Hall at 1101 Texas Avenue. The Brazos County Commissioners Court is scheduled to consider the portions of the street name changes outside the College Station City limits at their July 30, 2019 meeting. The United States Postal Service has informed us that the current addresses will continue to be recognized for mail delivery for up to one and a half years after the street name changes are implemented.
